An Impedance-Based Chemiresistor for the Real-Time, Simultaneous **Detection of Gut Microbiota-Generated Short-Chain Fatty Acids**

Short-chain fatty acids (SCFAs) are key molecules, produced by gut bacteria in the intestine, that are absorbed into the bloodstream and strongly influence human health. In this work, an electrochemical sensor was developed to enable real-time (requiring less than 2 min per measurement), quantitative measurement of SCFAs from complex samples in liquid phase without the need for extraction, evaporation, or destruction. Androgen deprivation therapy (ADT) is the standard care for advanced prostate cancer (PCa) patients. In this study, the authors performed a longitudinal study using their unique PCa patient-derived xenograft models and assessed B7-H3 expression during post-ADT disease progression. They further validated their findings at the clinical level in PCa patient samples. Abstract
