## A Longitudinal Single-Cell Atlas of Treatment Response in Pediatric AML

Pediatric acute myeloid leukemia (pAML) is characterized by heterogeneous cellular composition, driver alterations, and prognosis. Characterization of this heterogeneity and how it affects treatment response remains understudied in pediatric patients. Here, researchers used single-cell RNA sequencing and singlecell ATAC sequencing to profile 28 patients representing different pAML subtypes at diagnosis, remission, and relapse.
