Design and Evaluation of ZD06519, a Novel Camptothecin Payload for **Antibody Drug Conjugates**

In recent years, the field of antibody drug conjugates (ADCs) has seen a resurgence, largely driven by the clinical benefit observed in patients treated with ADCs incorporating camptothecin-based topoisomerase I inhibitor payloads. Here, researchers present the development of a novel camptothecin ZD06519, which has been specifically designed for its application as an ADC payload. Abstract
