Single-Cell Assessment of Primary and Stem Cell-Derived Human **Trophoblast Organoids As Placenta-Modeling Platforms**

Human trophoblast stem cells (hTSCs) and related trophoblast organoids are stateof-the-art culture systems that facilitate the study of trophoblast development and human placentation. Using single-cell transcriptomics, researchers evaluate how organoids derived from freshly isolated first-trimester trophoblasts or from established hTSC cell lines reproduce developmental cell trajectories and transcriptional regulatory processes defined in vivo. Type 2 innate lymphoid cells (ILC2s) perform vital functions in orchestrating humoral immune responses. Here, researchers utilized single cell RNA sequencing analysis to create the first comprehensive atlas of naïve and tumour-associated lung ILC2s and discover multiple unique subtypes of ILC2s equipped with developmental gene programs that become skewed during tumour expansion.
