Achievement of a stable surface coating with long-term resistance to biofilm formation remains a challenge. Researchers report a new approach based on supramolecular assembly to generate long-acting antibiofilm coating. They utilized catechol chemistry in combination with low molecular weight amphiphilic polymers for the generation of such coatings. Abstract
